Dear President,

I revert to the captioned matter and to our letters of 30 January and 6 February 2018.

In the past few months, United World Wrestling has been dealing with this issue to find a way to protect our Constitution and to ensure our rules are respected and complied with. It appeared that some principles provided in the Constitution with regards to the participation of UWW licensed athletes in competitions needed a clarification in the respective regulations.

During its meeting on 20 January 2018, the UWW Executive Committee adopted some amendments to the Transfer Regulations and the Disciplinary Regulations, as well as a new Licences Regulations. A communication about these changes will be circulated among all Member Federations in due course.

In light of these measures and considering all files received following the letter of 6 February, UWW will have the situation and each individual case reconsidered and reserves any decision in regard to the concerned Wrestlers. This reconsideration will occur shortly and at the latest until the end of April.

As a consequence, considering the number of athletes involved and the amount of information received, we hereby inform you that the suspension mentioned in our letters of 30 January and 6 February 2018 is not effective at this stage, respectively is lifted.

UWW will come back to you on this matter in the coming weeks.
